
Apprentices under 25

No more employer National Insurance contributions (NICs) will be payable on apprentices under 25.

To make it cheaper to employ young people, from April 2016 employers will not have to pay National Insurance contributions (NICs) for any apprentices aged under 25 earning less than £827.00 per week.

This is in addition to the announcement made at Autumn Statement last year that employers won't have to pay NICs on under 21s from April 2015.
