

Increase in National Minimum Wage and National Living Wage From 1 April 2020

For your information, please note the following increases in National Minimum Wage which will apply from 1 April 2020.

18-20	£ 6.15	£6.45
21 -24	£ 7.70	£8.20
25 & Over	£ 8.21	£8.72
Apprentice Rate *	£ 3.90	£4.15

Please note that this applies to ALL employees, so please ensure you apply the correct wage appropriately.

** This rate is for apprentices who are aged 16 to 18 and those aged 19 or over who are in their first year of their apprenticeship.*
